

**TOWN OF GREENE**  
**Regular Town Board Meeting**  
**February 16, 2022**

The regular meeting of the Greene Town Board was held on the above date at 6:00 PM at the Greene Town Hall, 51 Genesee Street, Greene, New York 13778.

**PRESENT:** Supervisor Joe Henninge, Council Members Bernie McDermott, Steve Page, Steve Northrup, Diane Flanagan, Superintendent Nick Drew.

Supervisor Henninge opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance led by Bryan Bernardi.

**MOTION** by Flanagan, seconded by Page to approve the amended minutes dated January 19, 2022 to include the addition of the Budget adjustments for 2021. Transfer \$6,559.25 from A.1990.4 to A.1410.1 \$4,794.05, A.1620.4 \$1,414.05, A.5010.4 \$99.30, A.5182.4 \$47.13, and A.9050.4 \$204.73.

Transfer \$108.71 from DA.9050.8 to DA.9035.8.

Transfer \$6,805.44 from DB.5110.1 to DB.5110.4.

Transfer \$3,549.15 from J2.7145.1 to J2.7145.4 (Basketball), \$1,125.25 from J2.7145.2 to J2.7145.4 (Basketball).

Council member Page mentioned that the JRC is still looking for applicants for the summer program director position. He noted the startup of the softball, t-ball season. The registration forms will be available on the Town website along with a pay pal option for donations.

Supervisor Henninge reported the Town has received and will be signing the Fire Contracts from the Village of Greene, Brisben Fire Department and Chenango Forks Fire Department.
